Privacy policy

The privacy policy describes the principles of our processing of information about you, including personal data and cookies, i.e. the so-called cookies.

1. General information

- This policy applies to the website operating at the following url: www.msaesthetic.pl
- 2. The website operator and personal data administrator is: MS Aesthetic Clinic Magdalena Szczytowska
- 3. The operator's e-mail address is: kontakt@msaesthetic.pl
- 4. The Operator is the Administrator of your personal data in relation to data provided voluntarily on the Website.
- 5. The website uses personal data for the following purposes:
 - Handling inquiries via the form
 - Handling goods orders preparation, packaging, shipping
 - Implementation of ordered services
 - Handling relevant accounting documents
 - Debt collection
 - Presentation of an offer or information
 - Legal execution of personal data by the Administrator his obligations pursuant to Art. 6 section 1 letter c) GDPR to the extent that specific provisions provide for it
- 6. The website performs the functions of obtaining information about users and their behavior in the following way:
 - By voluntarily entering data in forms that remain entered into the Operator's systems.
 - By saving cookies on end devices (so-called "cookies").

2. Selected data protection methods used by the Operator

1. 1. The places of logging in and entering personal data are protected in the transmission layer (SSL certificate). Thanks to this, personal data and login

details entered on the website are encrypted on the user's computer and can only be read on the target server.

- 2. In order to protect data, the Operator regularly makes backup copies.
- 3. An important element of data protection is the regular updating of all software used by the Operator to process personal data, which in particular means regular updates of components programming.

3. Hosting

The website is hosted (technically maintained) on the operator's servers.

4. Your rights and additional information about how your data is used

- In some situations, the Administrator has the right to transfer your personal data to other recipients if it is necessary to perform the contract concluded with you or to fulfill the obligations imposed on the Administrator. This applies to the following target groups:
 - persons authorized by us, employees and collaborators who must have access to personal data in order to perform their duties,
 - hosting company,
 - mailing companies,
 - companies handling SMS messages,
 - companies with which the Administrator cooperates in the field of own marketing,
 - couriers,
 - insurers,
 - law firms and debt collectors,
 - bank,
 - payment operators,
 - public authorities.
- 2. Your personal data processed by the Administrator no longer than is necessary to perform related activities specified in separate regulations (e.g. accounting). With respect to marketing data, data will not be processed for longer than 3 years.

- 3. You have the right to request from the Administrator:
 - access to personal data relating to you,
 - their corrections,
 - deletion,
 - processing restrictions,
 - and data transfer.
- 4. You have the right to object to the processing indicated in point 3.3 c) to the processing of personal data for the purpose of pursuing legally justified interests pursued by the Administrator, including profiling, but the right to object will not be possible if there are valid legally justified grounds for processing, interests, rights and freedoms that override you, in particular the establishment, exercise or defense of claims.
- 5. You may lodge a complaint against the Administrator's actions to the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection, ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw.
- 6. Providing personal data is voluntary, but necessary to operate the Website.
- 7. Activities involving automated decision-making may be undertaken in relation to you, including profiling, in order to provide services under the concluded contract and for the purpose of conducting direct marketing by the Administrator.
- 8. Personal data is not transferred from third countries within the meaning of personal data protection regulations. This means that we do not send them outside the European Union.

5. Information in forms

- 1. The website collects information provided voluntarily by the user, including personal data, if provided.
- 2. The website may save information about connection parameters (time stamp, IP address).
- 3. In some cases, the website may save information that makes it easier to link the data in the form with the e-mail address of the user completing the form. In this case, the user's e-mail address appears inside the URL of the page containing the form.

4. The data provided in the form is processed for the purpose resulting from the function of a specific form, e.g. to process a service request or a commercial contact, register services, etc. Each time, the context and description of the form clearly inform what it is used for.

6. Windows Administrator

1. Information about user behavior on the website may be subject to logging. This data is used to administer the website.

7. Important marketing techniques

1. The operator uses statistical analysis of website traffic via Google Analytics (Google Inc. based in the USA). The operator does not transfer personal data to the operator of this service, only anonymized information. The service is based on the use of cookies on the user's end device. In terms of information about user preferences collected by the Google advertising network, the user

can view and edit information resulting from cookies using the tool: https://www.google.com/ads/preferences/

2. The Operator uses remarketing techniques that allow advertising messages to be matched to the user's behavior on the website, which may give the illusion that the user's personal data are used to track him, but in practice, no personal data is transferred from the Operator to advertising operators. The technological condition for such activities is that cookies are enabled.

3. The operator uses the Facebook pixel. This technology allows Facebook (Facebook Inc. based in the USA) to know that a given person registered there uses the Website. In this case, it is based on data for which it is itself the administrator; the Operator does not provide any additional personal data to Facebook. The service is based on the use of cookies on the user's end device.

4. The operator uses a solution that examines user behavior by creating heat maps and recording behavior on the website. This information is anonymized before it is sent to the service operator so that it does not know which natural person it relates to. In particular, entered passwords and other personal data are not recorded. 5. The Operator uses a solution that automates the operation of the Website for users, e.g., which can send an e-mail to the user after visiting a specific subpage, provided that he or she has agreed to receive commercial correspondence from the Operator.

8. Information about cookies

- 1. The website uses cookies.
- Cookies (so-called "cookies") are IT data, in particular files text files that are stored on the Website User's end device and are intended for using the Website's websites. Cookies usually contain the name of the website they come from, their storage time on the end device and a unique number.
- 3. The entity that places cookies on the Website User's end device and obtains access to them is the Website operator.
- 4. Cookies are used for the following purposes:
 - maintaining the Website user's session (after logging in), thanks to which

the user does not have to re-enter it on each subpage of the Website login and password;

- 5. The Website uses two basic types of cookies: "session" (session cookies) and "persistent cookies". "Session" cookies are temporary files that are stored on the User's end device until logging out, leaving the website or turning off the software (web browser). "Permanent" cookies are stored on the User's end device for the time specified in the cookie parameters or until they are deleted by the User.
- 6. Software for browsing websites (web browser) usually allows cookies to be stored on the User's end device by default. Website users may change the settings in this regard. The web browser allows you to delete cookies. It is also possible to automatically block cookies. Detailed information on this subject can be found in the help or documentation of your web browser.
- 7. Restrictions on the use of cookies may affect some of the functionalities available on the Website.

- Cookies placed on the Website User's end device may also be used by entities cooperating with the Website operator, in particular the following companies: Google (Google Inc. based in the USA), Facebook (Facebook Inc. based in the USA), Twitter (Twitter Inc. based in the USA).
- 9. If you do not want to receive cookies, you can change your browser settings.
